Ceiling Installation

GENERAL:

1. Before starting the installation, make sure all electricity has been turned off and electrical breaker has been locked out and tagged out.
2. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
3. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electrical Code.
4. Do not use the luminaire near heating appliances or elements.
5. Not intended for use with emergency exits.
6. All luminaires to be installed by a qualified electrician.

NOTE: The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur.

INSTALLATION:

1. Fasten the safety rope to the back of the luminaire (**Figure 1**).
2. Drill 4 Ø0.31 inch anchor screw holes and one Ø1.57 to 2.36 inch wire hole in the ceiling as pictured (**Figure 2**).
3. Screw in the 4 plastic anchors into the pre-drilled holes (**Figure 3**).
4. Connect the wires using wire nuts then attached the safety rope to the ceiling. Secure the luminaire to the ceiling by tightening the tapping screws (**Figure 4**).

NOTE: Make sure the luminaire is grounded and wires are insulated.

NOTE: To prevent wire damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects.

IMPORTANT: Do not disassemble, modify, or drop the LED canopy light.

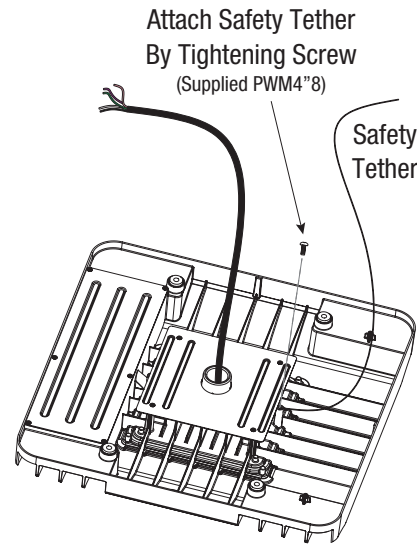

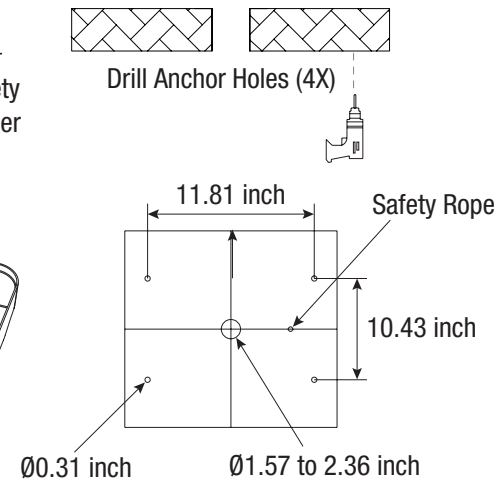
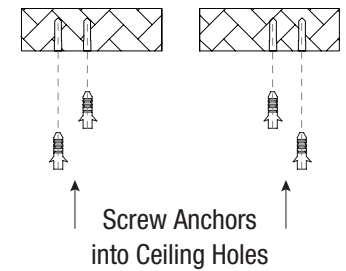

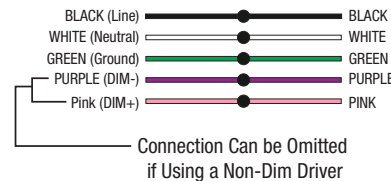
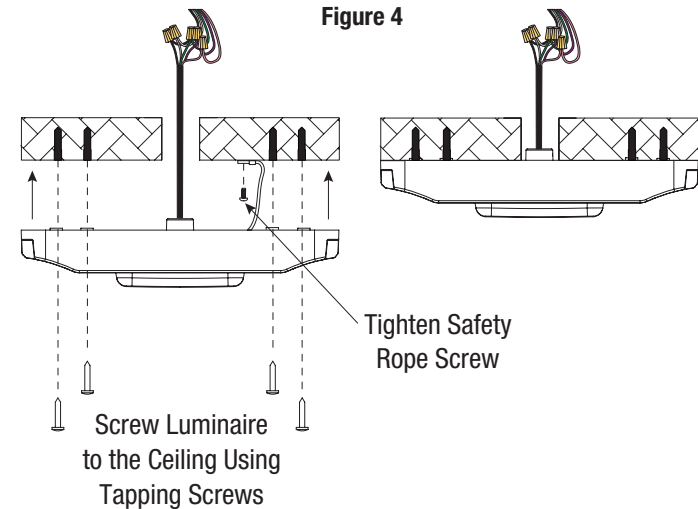

DETAILED ILLUSTRATION

Pendant Installation

GENERAL:

1. Before starting the installation, make sure all electricity has been turned off and electrical breaker has been locked out and tagged out.
2. To ensure the success of the installation, be sure to read these instructions and review the diagrams thoroughly before beginning.
3. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electrical Code.
4. These luminaires are intended to be mounted to a J-Box directly supported by the building structure.
5. Not intended for use with emergency exits.
6. All luminaires to be installed by a qualified electrician.

NOTE: The important safeguards and instructions appearing in this manual are not meant to cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur.

INSTALLATION:

1. Wire In-Line Wire Splices in tandem so it can feed thru pipe (**Figure 1**).

NOTE: Make sure the luminaire is grounded and wires are insulated.

2. Apply Threadlocker (Supplied by Others) to rigid conduit threads prior to tightening.
3. Securely tighten rigid conduit until pipe bottoms out and torque MAX 50 IN-LBS prior to locking with screw.
4. Tighten screw to prevent rotation (**Figure 2**).

NOTE: To prevent wire damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects.

IMPORTANT: Do not disassemble, modify, or drop the LED canopy light.

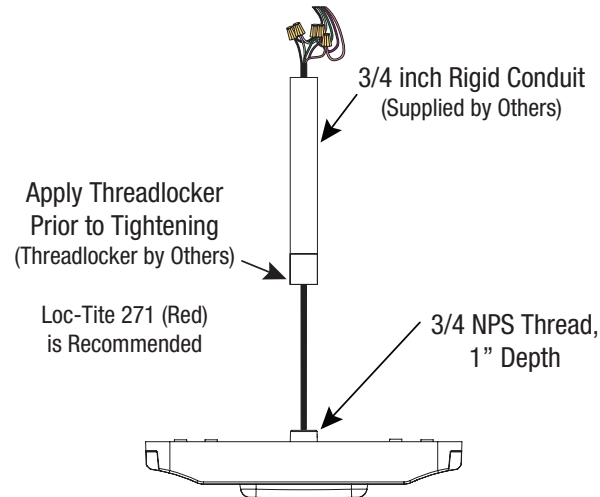
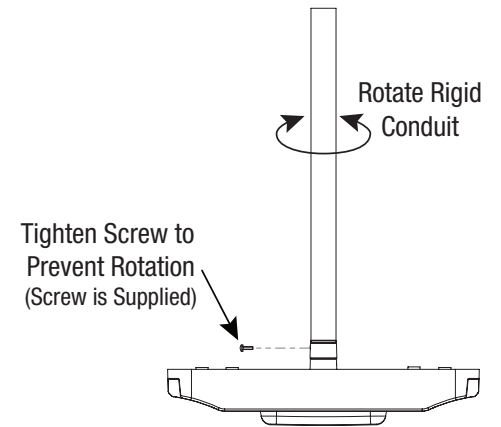
